



AUD Spring 2024 Guidelines on Returning to Campus

As per the latest Dubai Health Authority, DHA, rules and regulations regarding updates on precautionary measures, and instructions against spread of SARS-COV-2 announced December 12, 2023, kindly note that:

1. Home Isolation for Infected COVID-19 cases:

- Home Isolation for five (5) days **is not** anymore mandatory, and a sick leave is granted to the infected individuals according to the assessment of the case by the attending physician.
- Similar to flu or other respiratory infectious diseases and according to the severity of the disease.

2. People in contact with COVID-19 Cases:

- PCR test is only required upon the symptoms' presence.

3. Wearing Masks:

- Commitment of wearing masks by infected and suspected cases of SARS-COV-2 virus.
- Masks is optional for workforce in the health facilities, patients and visitors.
- Wearing masks is recommended for elderly people, chronic diseases patients as well as people vulnerable for infection (e.g. immunosuppressed) in both open and closed areas.
