Per AUD nomenclature “major” means a specialization within a program. Hence, Business Administration, Communication and Information Studies, International Studies, Architecture, Visual Communication and Interior Design are programs. Marketing Communications, Finance and Management are examples of majors within the Business Administration program.

AUD’s School of Engineering offers four undergraduate degree programs: Civil, Computer, Electrical, and Mechanical Engineering. The number of credit hours required by each program is clearly stated in the appropriate sections. Optional majors (where applicable) are also listed, together with the required credit hours for each.
